LIVING BY THE PROMISES OF GOD

This charge and admonition I commit in trust to you, Timothy, my son, in accordance with prophetic intimations which I formerly received concerning you, so that inspired and aided by them you may wage the good warfare,

Holding fast to faith that leaning of the entire human personality on God in absolute trust and confidence) and having a good (clear) conscience. By rejecting and thrusting from them [their conscience], some individuals have made shipwreck of their faith". 1 Timothy 1: 18-19

Paul is instructing Timothy out of his own life experience, telling him to fight the fight with the promises that have been given to him.

We can live in the secret place, day by day by the promises of God. Anytime there is any measure of opposition, discouragement, challenge, confusion; doesn't matter what it is, we can read the Word of God continually until we hear His voice. Even if our circumstances will not change we have the fuel, the focus and the faith for what is about to change. We can endure the difficulty knowing that God sees the big picture and that He sees us already, where we need to be in the future and there is a promise from God to get us there.

Whenever God is giving you a promise it's because He knows the future and He knows where you will be, so He can give you a Word of Knowledge (dream/vision/prophecy) that is necessary to get you there down His path for you.

Any area of our lives that doesn't have hope is under the influence of a lie. The way we have hope is to get a promise from the Lord and vision for life.

Some people sit back and wait for God to come to them. They have turned their life into soaking and waiting for God to come to them instead of to lean in anticipating His voice.

Paul is teaching Timothy to bring light in every dark place, and find those whom he can trust to live the same way. God will talk to you about everything in your life. He counted every hair on your head and He will give you something to fight with. Jesus already fought for you, now He wants you to fight with the promises.

Paul is instructing Timothy to take care of himself first, so that he can next take care of the church that he is serving, then he can have impact on kings and leaders, who then can bring peace in the entire city.

We will encounter tribulations in the world, but at least live in the light with a promise, that God will come into your life suddenly and do a miracle.



There is something about holding onto God's promises for our lives that keeps us victorious in a good conscience which is the most priceless element that you have in your life. You don't engage in a battle if you don't have the confidence of a good conscience. Every one of us will weaken our efforts in a conflict if we have a conscience that accuses us.

WHAT ARE YOU FACING THAT LOOKS IMPOSSIBLE? A GIANT?

Any situation you have such as a fear issue, anxiety, negative circumstances, family member that is not saved; God has a promise that will handle each giant. Why did Jesus pray, if everything was going to happen as He planned? He wouldn't need to pray would he? Why did he raise the dead? Because not everybody dies in God's time. One of the works of the will of God is dreams and desires of God which means many things are not decided yet. Jesus' intention is to honour the Father as it is in heaven, as should it be our intention.

There is a great distance between what we experience and what is in His heart and that gap is closed with promises that become activated inside people. If we have not asked for a promise it will never work out. Sometimes we're in a situation that we need to hear from God and He doesn't talk. And many times He doesn't talk because He already talked to us perhaps through His Word and we forgot or weren't listening. Maybe 6 months ago He gave you this word and you overlooked it. He is never silent out of punishment; He is silent to help us discover what He already said. Many times our answers are in His Word, but we don't want to follow what He's saying, as perhaps it runs against our doctrine or personal thinking and so we wail out to God for a different promise or direction. It won't work.

We start seeing the spiritual realm totally different and our spiritual senses are opened when we follow God's Word and His voice and live by His promises.

God wants us to live in abundance like in [Jeremiah 31](#), not to live enough just to get by. He wants to heal our wounds; He wants us to enjoy our lives before we get to heaven, He wants us to inherit a superabundant overflowing of blessings.

Many Christians repent enough to be forgiven but not enough to see the kingdom. And many Christians have enough to get by but not enough to live in the fullness of God's promises. The Lord will release extraordinary resources for the purposes of generosity. Not just to provide food and money for the needy but literally to break the cycle of systemic poverty, where there has been multiple generations that have been living in a lack lifestyle that they see no way to get out of what they've inherited. There are many people who have been raised in that environment that don't know how to break loose. Pray; do spiritual warfare; study and apply God's Word; ask the Holy Spirit to fill you and teach you and go after living in the promises of God!

My prayer and desire is for every person who has the desire, to come into the fullness of who they are in their gift to be rewarded. I pray that God will release all His promised blessings upon you. I pray that any and all curses are broken. I pray for a healing of the land under you will take place and the healing of all your wounds.

Live on that promise!
