



A typical definition of a superhero is someone possessing "extraordinary or superhuman powers" and dedicated to protecting the public.

When I was a boy there were superheroes as The Lone Ranger, Zorro and Superman. They didn't sit around and let the bad guys win. They were power in action!

Some had superpowers; all were extraordinary.

Does this sound like you?

It better sound like you if you call yourself a Christian!



Jesus said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it." John 14:12-14 NKJV

So according to the Word of God, people who believe in Jesus will do the same and better works than Jesus did!

That means that the 2 billion people in the world that say they're Christian should each be doing greater works than Jesus did, according to the Word of God, which doesn't lie.

Yet we all know that isn't happening!

If it were happening, the other 4 billion people in the world would be astounded at all the billions of daily miracles and would quickly realize who the true God of heaven and earth is!

So who is dropping the ball... God or those calling themselves Christian?

That was an easy question I know!

But is the answer "why?" an easy answer?

I believe the answer is an easy one and is also in the Word.

As I wrote in my book in the Sector "DIG For It" there are certain factors that come into play if doing what Jesus did and even greater works, is to become a reality.

Notice the first big 2 letter underlined word that Jesus says further on in the Book of John...

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him." John 14:23 NKJV

There are over 1500 "ifs" in the Bible!

"If my people... shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven..." 2 Chronicles 7:14

So now... how many of the 2 billion drop off the Superhero abilities list just in failing to follow this 1 scripture!

Shall I go on?

If you love me keep my commandments." John 14:15

That's an ignored scripture for most people. Referring back to the above scripture in John 14:23, if you don't keep His commandments you don't really love Him, as those who love Him, "will keep My word".

Let's look at some more:

“Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this,” Says the LORD of hosts, “ If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.” Malachi 3:10 NKJV

If you've made it this far you're doing pretty good as one of God's Superheroes, as not that many people are humble, pray, seek His face, turn from their wicked ways, keep His commandments and tithe. And that's just studying 4 scriptures in God's Word of what He'll do If you do what He asks. God's Superheroes are obedient to Him!

We can't possibly look over 1500 “ifs” in the Word so let's refine it down a bit more for those who should be striving to do the same and greater works than Jesus did... to be a Superhero... SuperChristian!

“For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.” Matthew 6:14-15

“God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.” John 4:24

“He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.” John 7:18

Have you and do you continually forgive, worship in spirit and truth and seek no glory for yourself?

“Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?” Galatians 3:3

OK... what does that one mean? It means that people initially believe and have faith in a spiritual salvation when they accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior and yet continue on living a flesh-controlled life. Even well-intentioned motives are flesh-controlled if not coming from Father. They don't have Holy Spirit power working through them!

Jesus never did anything of His own will! He led a totally Spirit-led, Spirit-powered life! Every miracle, every word He said, every action, came to Him from His (and our) Father! Jesus absolutely surrendered to His Father!

Jesus said, **“I have glorified You (Father) on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.” John 17:4**

I know of an American missionary couple that spent 5 years in the Philippines. When they came back to the US they admitted that they hadn't brought a single person to Christ! Why? Because they thought it would be a good idea to be missionaries there. They weren't Spirit led or Spirit controlled while there. God never sends you out to fail!

I know of a very successful spiritual warfare minister who twice tried to start a church and it failed both times. When he finally went to God to find out why, God said to him, “Did I tell you to start a church?”

I know of a successful international Xtreme Big Game Hunter from Mexico who prepared for 2 years to go on a mission in Asia. On her way there at a stopover in Paris, God asked her where she was going. In 2 years she had never once gone to God for His approval or direction. God told her to go back to Mexico! She did! Wise move!

I know of another leader who thinks God wants them in a certain fellowship, yet the people there contradict and compromise with the Word of God. If you think you hear God, but what you're doing contradicts or compromises with His Word, then you're hearing wrong. God never contradicts or compromises with His written Word!

These people that I mention above are just 4 leaders that didn't follow the Word of God. This kind of pride, disobedience, self-will, self-glory and self-idolization is typical among Christians. It should be rare among leaders! Is it any wonder that Christians aren't doing as Jesus did... or greater? Where's God's Superheroes?

STOP making your own decisions! If you're in ministry now, go to God immediately, and from now on, to receive moment-by-moment instructions. You may be shocked to find out... you're on a collision course with failure!

... how, where and when He says... or you're flying solo!**
