UNICEF says about 1/3rd of the world are less than 15 years old.

WHAT ARE CHRISTIAN LEADERS, PARENTS AND ADULTS DOING WITH THEIR RESPONSIBILITY TO THIS VAST GROUP?

Parents, leaders and adults, what are you doing about the spiritual training of your children and youth?

Are you equipping them in the power of God, and teaching them how to live in the anointing... or are you sending them to another room to draw pictures and watch cartoons?

Do you think that kind of stuff is going to equip a person in how to work in the spirit? If any spiritual being, especially the young, doesn't experience God's presence and holy supernatural ways, then eventually they'll go somewhere else to find it.

How many have ever evangelized children?

Most adults think, "what can a child do?"

Let's see what God thinks...

God sent Samuel out to anoint the new king. Even the wise prophet Samuel, was operating in a "box" mentality, as he thought the chosen one was Eliab because he was the eldest and best looking. "But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7

Let's look at God's pick...

"So he sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, with bright eyes, and good-looking. And the LORD said, "Arise, anoint him; for this is the one!" Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward." 1 Samuel 16:12-13

God anointed a youth to be king over a nation of people and filled him with the Holy Spirit.

King Saul was also in a mental "box" as he considered David a worthless warrior due to his youth.

"And Saul said to David, "You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are a youth, and he (Goliath) a man of war from his youth." 1 Samuel 17:33

We all know the outcome of that short battle!

Adults think it foolish to give a child or a youth responsibility or to take one seriously. "But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty." 1 Corinthians 1:27

So parents and leaders ignore them or send them off somewhere else while they tend to their "adult business."

Where does someone go for spiritual nourishment when they can't get it from Christian leaders and parents?

They go to the occult, witchcraft, satanism, new age and false religions.

Most parents and even Christians don't see what the harm is in that, because they think it's all innocent, harmless fun if a child is casting spells thanks to Harry Potter type books or information they find on the internet or learn at school.

It's time Christian adults woke up and started operating in the spirit to see that the evil realm is wise enough to use and work with children and youth and that a large part of God's army are not only go to waste, but adults are even willingly allowing their kids to be slaves and captives of satan!

But aren't cute little Sunday school Bible stories the way to go?

Let's look at some real testimonies with God's power in kids...

Here's a quote from "Kids in Combat" by David Walters, from an effective assembly in Missouri that uses all its members... "The children had been praying for the sick, prophesying, giving words of knowledge etc. I heard a little guy of about 6 years old prophesy to a large, tall man. Laying his hand on the man's tummy, because that's all he could reach, he said, "God's going to give you a lot of money, yes a lot of money. Then you can help people, you can give them some." A couple of people standing near smiled. You could see their thoughts on their faces, "How sweet, what a cute little boy..."

The Pastor heard this prophecy and confirmed that this boy was unaware that an “adult” prophet had said the same thing to the same man (with “adult” wording)! The boy said it the way he did, only in a young boy’s language.

Here’s another one... “Some years ago at an assembly in Oklahoma City, the kids were learning how to move in the power of God. There had been a lot of miracles. On the last day, one of the elders backed his car out of the garage and ran over their little toddler. The baby went blue and stopped breathing. The man's wife became frantic and rushed to call the emergency. Their other children, (who had been in the meetings) said, "Don't worry, Jesus will heal her" and without delay ran and laid hands on the child and prayed for her. Immediately the toddler sat up and started breathing and the color came back into her face. She was perfectly fine.”

And another true account... “One time in a church in Florida seven children each independently asked if they could attend the Wednesday evening service, as God had asked each of them to go. The parent who was to drive them home said, “They all came out of the church limping! I knew there was nothing wrong with them in the natural, so I got them all in my van (7 of them including my own two girls, between ages 7-10) and took them to my friend's house. We sat them all down and said "Right... we are going to ask God what is going on and what He is saying? And why you are all limping." We waited on the Lord for a little while then one by one they sat up and spoke. "God said, these people (in the church) asked Me (God) to come, but now they don't want Me," the first one said. "God said, the people asked Me to send my Holy Spirit, but when He started to move they didn't like it, so He is going to leave," the second child said. "This church is going to close." Another said. "In two weeks," said the next one. Then another child said, "And the pastor is going to leave his wife." Finally they said, "Can we go outside and play now?" My friend looked at me and said, "I don't think we should tell people about this." "No." I agreed. Guess what? In three weeks the church had closed, and it was a good sized church. And the pastor took off and left his wife and family.”

God uses children and the youth, especially when He can't use adults, because of the adult's sin, fears, ignorance, indifference, pride and religiosity.

The Holy Spirit has a “one size fits all” label attached. There’s no junior Holy Spirit!

How would you like someone at the next meeting you attend, to hand you a coloring book and crayons and ask you to sit in another room and be quiet?

How powerful or effective would you become as a Christian with the Holy Spirit?

Where would you turn to get someone to appreciate what you're capable of?

Why are leaders, parents and adults doing it then... to children and youth? Makes zero sense.

Isn't everyone aware that Islamic nations (there are about 50 muslim majority nations in the world) are training their children and youth in their schools and mosques to be religious, murderous zealots against Christians? Yet Christians give their kids coloring books, video games or even worse, force them to sit and listen to a spiritually dead service/meeting devoid of any demonstrations of God's power. These kids can't wait to be old enough to get away from dry, dead religion. I know because I was one of them!

WAKE UP!!!

You're not only failing to properly lead and direct children and youth into a proper life with God but your also ignoring a vast untapped army that God wants Christian leaders, parents and adults to train, equip and utilize against satan!

Remember also... one day you must give an account of yourself to God for what you did with your life. Will one of His questions be, “Why did you let children rot, fall to the wayside and not assist them to fulfill their destiny?”

I know this question will be asked of all the pastors at the churches I went to when I was a kid.
